Dear Member:

Once again the wail of the beagle will prevail over the club's ground on Sunday, March 6; weather permitting. From the events of previous beagle trials the rabbits will lead many of the dogs on a long, hard chase. Discussions by trial enthusiasts indicate that the rabbits at the club are better educated in eluding the dogs, and those dogs capable of out-thinking the rabbit are led on good long runs. With activities dwindling this time of year you would find this an enjoyable manner in which to spend sometime and maybe participate in a new sport. Breakfast at the Club House will be served at 7:30 A.M., charges nominal, and dinner will be served promptly at 12 noon, donation \$1.25. This day and age who could ever complain at those prices. The Women's Chapter has been doing an excellent job. Many thanks girls!

Developments since the last newsletter in January are: 1) Club's share of profit from Xmas trees was \$184.50.; 2) One hundred folding chairs were purchased; 3) Game on the club's land was fed during the recent snowstorms; 4) To date, 90 members have paid their 1966 dues. Prompt payment of dues by those delinquent members would be appreciated; 5) Work parties are very limited to a few faithful members. This speaker is very timely and the topic of interest to many with the coming of Spring and the year for a trip outdoors after a long, cold, winter.

## **Range Status**

The range is currently open as usual for members to use. Please remember that every Friday is reserved for Special Activities. Before heading to the range, members should always check the Calendar of Events under the Members Corner on the Chapter website for current range status information. Range use is occasionally limited due to training classes and other events.

The 200-yard berm improvements are still not complete. Until this work is completed, the 200-yard range is not available for use.

Any guest using the range must be supervised by a Chapter member with Range Safety Officer credentials. A fee of \$5.00 for each guest is to be paid at the donation box under the sign-in box. **Only one bench may be used by the member and guest.** The same guest may visit the range only two times a year. The guest fee and two-visit limit do not apply to the immediate family of members.
