## Minutes - Director's Meeting - 4 May 1966

The meeting was called to order by President LeRoy Strawsburg.

The president said the State Division of the IWLA would hold their quarterly meeting at our club house on 17 July 1966.

The directors decided to hold a raffel again this year. The prizes would be the same as last year and John Fox was appointed chairman.

A nominating committee was appointed by the president; Bill Warren as Chairman and Dick Tyeryar as co-chairman. The rest of the committee will be selected at the next regular meeting.

The directors voted to use a gas stove in the club house for cooking since the electric stoves were not big enough to do the job and a large gas stove was available.

The meeting was adjourned.

## Minutes - Regular Meeting - 11 May 1966

The meetingwas called to order by President LeRoy Strawsburg. The minutes from the previous meeting were read and approved.

Four new members were accepted by the Club. They were David E. Blackledge, Joseph T. Grumbine, Jr., George C. Pryor and Earnest Moxley.

The Treasurer gave his report and the Club has a balance of \$295.89 in the general fund and \$313.02 in Loyala Federal for the purpose of paying notes. The balance in the building fund is \$579.94.

Austin Baumgardner, Chairman of the building committee, discussed the work remaining to be completed on the building. A decision was made to hold work details on Monday evenings.

The Club purchased two gas stoves for use in the Club house for \$25.00. The ten burner stove will be installed and the six burner stove will be sold. The Club should also sell the heatrola and one electric stove.

The last beagle trial for the 1965-66 season was held on 17 April 1966. The trials for the year showed a profit of \$193.73 which will be turned over to the general treasurer.

A motion was made by Bill Warren and seconded by Charles Baker for the treasurer to buy and set up a general ledger book. The motion was passed by the members.

Three members were appointed to the nominating committee to assist Chairman Bill Warren and Co-Chairman, Dick Tyeryar. They were Earl Wiles, Lewis Boyer and John Turner, Jr.

A motion was made by Gary Boyer and seconded by Raymond Clem to place a barricade across the road to the pond and have the club house keys fit the lock. The motion was passed by the members.

August 10, 1966 was announced as the date for the raffel drawing.

The meeting was adjourned and refreshment were served.

#### **Range Status**

The range is currently open as usual for members to use. Please remember that every Friday is reserved for Special Activities. Before heading to the range, members should always check the Calendar of Events under the Members Corner on the Chapter website for current range status information. Range use is occasionally limited due to training classes and other events.

The 200-yard berm improvements are still not complete. Until this work is completed, the 200-yard range is not available for use.

Any guest using the range must be supervised by a Chapter member with Range Safety Officer credentials. A fee of \$5.00 for each guest is to be paid at the donation box under the sign-in box. **Only one bench may be used by the member and guest.** The same guest may visit the range only two times a year. The guest fee and two-visit limit do not apply to the immediate family of members.
