June 1966

MINUTES - Regular Meeting, 13 July 1966

The meeting was called to order by President LeRoy Strawsburg. The minutes from the previous meeting were read and approved.

Five new members were accepted by the club. They were Lloyd M. Fogle, James D. Duncan, James Montgomery, Charles Cosgrove, and John R. Eckinrode.

The treasurer gave his report with a balance of \$695.64 in general fund and \$312.02 in Loyola Federal.

The president reported that the conservation man had been contacted to determine the feasibility of a small pond on the club house grounds. As of this date he has not made a report for the club.

Progress on the club house is continuing with the floor being laid and doors installed on the kitchen cupboards.

The rafel ticket sales has been moving slow but is expected to pick up.

William Warren gave a report from the Frederick County Council meeting. In response to their request the following resolution was made by the club, "If there is a law against the use of incendiary ammunition the Fred. Chapter #1 of the IWLA is opposed to the public sale of same." The proposal was made by Manual Barbeito and seconded by Phil Yost and passed by the club.

A committee was appointed by the president to organize a casting clinic or demonstration in late July or early August. Services of Lefty Kreh would be available at this time. Appointed to serve were Dick Kreh, Phil Yost, Austin Baumgardner and James Windsor.

Dr. Warren Evans showed slides and movies on the outdoor school and education center at Camp Greentop.

The meeting was adjourned and refreshments were served.

Range Status

The range is currently open as usual for members to use. Please remember that every Friday is reserved for Special Activities. Before heading to the range, members should always check the Calendar of Events under the Members Corner on the Chapter website for current range status information. Range use is occasionally limited due to training classes and other events.

The 200-yard berm improvements are still not complete. Until this work is completed, the 200-yard range is not available for use.

Any guest using the range must be supervised by a Chapter member with Range Safety Officer credentials. A fee of \$5.00 for each guest is to be paid at the donation box under the sign-in box. **Only one bench may be used by the member and guest.** The same guest may visit the range only two times a year. The guest fee and two-visit limit do not apply to the immediate family of members.
