## **ACTIVITIES AND FUND RAISING**

(Currently in need of Chair person/s)

The **Annual Grounds and Property Cleanup** event is scheduled for Saturday and Sunday, 25th & 26th March!! We will improve the Chapter property as well as clean Clubhouse floors, furniture, windows, paint bathroom floors, and remove excess equipment from the clubhouse. We will have a detailed worklist that you can choose items from for accomplishment and will begin each day at 0900. Don't plan on more than 3 hours each day and we can get a lot done and still have time for some socializing after each session.

# CONSERVATION

Our monthly Conservation Committee meeting was held February 6, 2023 at the clubhouse. Next meeting is Monday, March 6, 2023 at 6pm. We will discuss our upcoming March and April conservation events including resumption of chemical water testing (3/25), the completion of the

Perimeter Trail (3/25), and the start of monitoring the Eastern Bluebird nesting boxes (first full week of March).



We had a successful Perimeter Trail Clearing Event Saturday morning, February 11, 2023 clearing and maintaining the Perimeter Trail from the shooting range, down toward the train tracks, and up the hill to the Diamond Dog Resort property. Those participating were: Marvin Gibson, Matt Lohaus, Mike Moneypenny, Mike Morgan, Jake Bise, Josh Phipps, Dave Carlson, and Preston Wood.



We are close to completing the trail. There is not much work left to attach to the existing trail near the stream and bamboo grove. This forestry and silviculture work is being done in accordance with our property Conservation Easement while managing the forest by removing growth that is choking mature trees which also increases sunlight. When completed, we will have a path around the entire Frederick#1 Chapter property which will facilitate better access for members and emergency personnel if needed.

We will finish the Perimeter Trail at 8am, Saturday March 25, 2023 connecting to the existing trail by the stream during the Chapter's Annual Grounds Clean Up. We should have this done by noon that day. We need members with chainsaws and tree branch loppers.





On Sunday morning, February 12<sup>th</sup>, scouts from <u>Cub Scout Pack 796</u> assisted us in making our Bluebird nesting boxes ready for the breeding season. Scouts helped take off the wire mesh and thumb tacks, that were keeping the mice out, allowing the birds access to the ten boxes around the property and the pond.



The Cub Scouts learned about Eastern Blue Birds and their important role in our ecology while being introduced to our IWLA conservation programs, got lots of fresh air, and hiked one mile in total. This event was part of our conservation education outreach to the community. Members participating in guiding the Scouts on the property and showing them the Bluebird boxes were John Gallo, Steve Meyer, and Preston Wood.



We are looking for Chapter member volunteers to check the Eastern Bluebird Nesting boxes starting this month. Commitment would be once a month from March to September visiting each of the 10 boxes checking for occupancy and brood size, if any, and reporting data collected. Inspection sheets to record data will be available. Please contact Preston Wood (woodpreston@yahoo.com) to get on the rotation schedule. We will be begin our nesting box monitoring this month, and will discuss our plans at the March Conservation meeting, Monday March 6<sup>th</sup> 6pm.



We will resume chemical water testing **Saturday, March 25, 2023 at 10am** at Ballenger Creek. Invertebrate monitoring will occur twice a year, initially, and increase with greater participation support. IWLA Frederick Chapter #1 Save our Streams program provides testing and long-term water chemistry data on select streams in Frederick County Maryland. The Izaak Walton League's Save Our Streams program is the only nationwide program training volunteers to protect waterways from pollution and bring information about water quality to their communities.



Our Chapter is participating in National IWLA's Salt Watch program to determine the impact of road salt changing the salinity of our streams. **We're asking each member of our Chapter** to go to the National IWLA website (<u>https://www.iwla.org/water/stream-monitoring/salt-watch</u>) and order your free Salt Watch kit, then test salt levels in your local waterways after it snows and add your findings to a national database.

Plan to help the IWLA in this vital work supporting the League's strategic goal "To conserve, restore, and promote the sustainable use and enjoyment of our natural resources, including soil, air, woods, waters, and wildlife."
